**ENROLLMENT CONTRACT
TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. The Skating School reserves the right to cancel or change time of lessons.
2. Students who miss a regularly scheduled class may do a “make-up: provided that it is performed on or before the third week before the end of the semester. For any other missed classes, students will receive a public session pass which must be used before the end of the current semester. Some specialty classes (such as Stroking, Ice Babies, etc.) may not have make-up options.
3. Cancellation of the remaining part of an enrollment may be made under the following conditions:
 - (a) The Skating School must receive written notice of cancellation, stating reason.
 - (b) Cancellations can only be made during the first three (3) weeks of any semester.
 - (c) All Regularly scheduled classes which have been taught up to the cancellation date (whether attended or not) shall be deducted from the refund.
 - (d) Public session pass cards must be returned at time of cancellation or they will be deducted from the refund whether any weekly public sessions were used or not. When pass cards are returned, any public session passes used in excess of one (1) per week shall be deducted from the refund. Max value per session is \$7.00 (seven dollars).
 - (e) All ISI fees are not refundable.
 - (f) Refunds will be mailed within thirty (30) days of cancellation.
4. The student and parent or legal guardian understand that ice skating, like most athletic activities, has a degree of unpredictability and risk involved with it and that injuries can and sometimes do occur. The student and parent or legal guardian understand and assume the risks involved in the activity for which the student is enrolling, agree that neither Bakersfield Ice Sports Center (BISC) nor any of its employees shall be liable for any and all injuries that may occur to the student or with regard to any damages to personal property, and agree indemnify and hold BISC and its employees harmless from any claims, damages, costs, including reasonable attorney fees, that might arise out of students participation in this activity.
